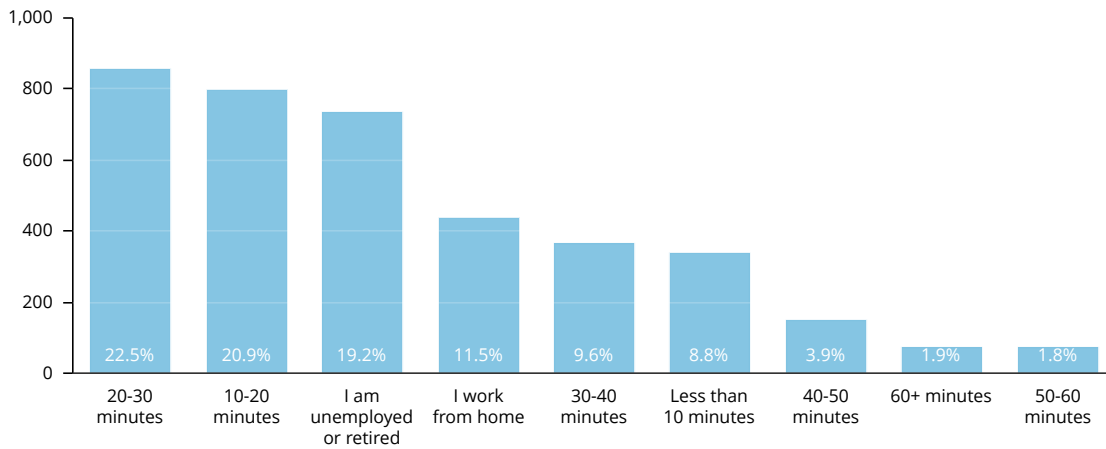

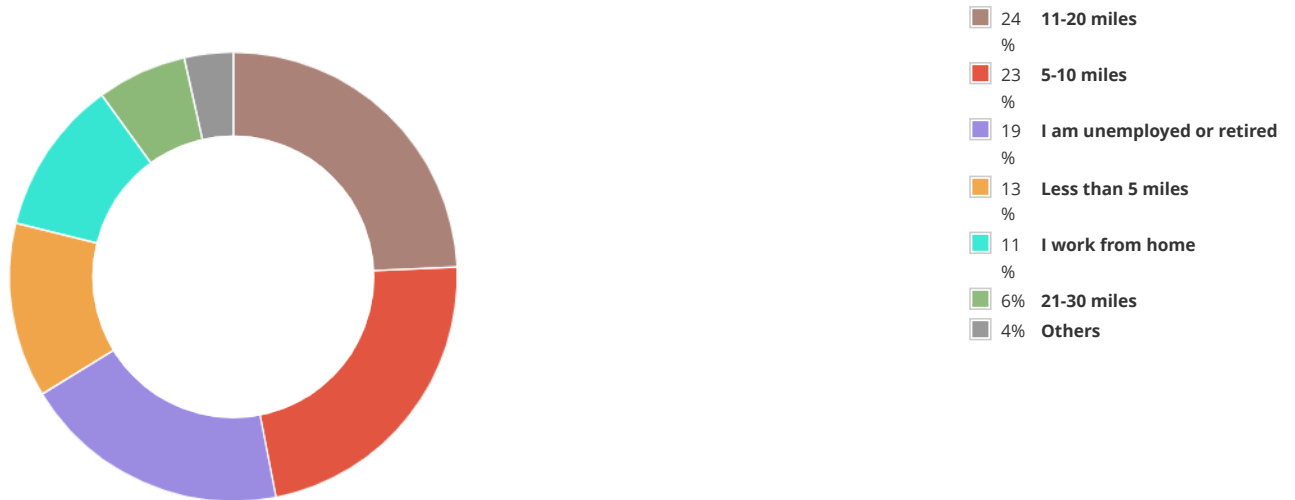

11. How many minutes does it typically take you to commute from home to work (one way)?

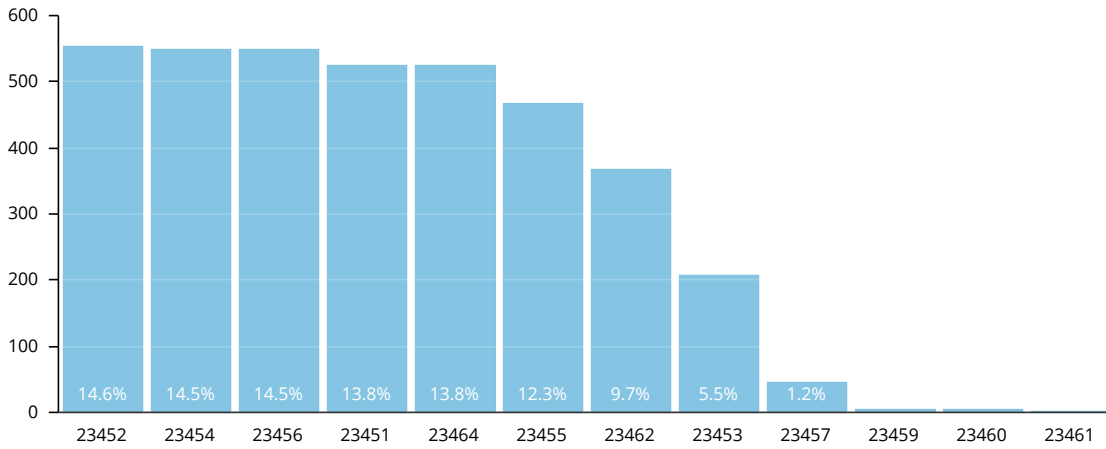


12. What is the approximate one-way distance in miles between your home and your work?

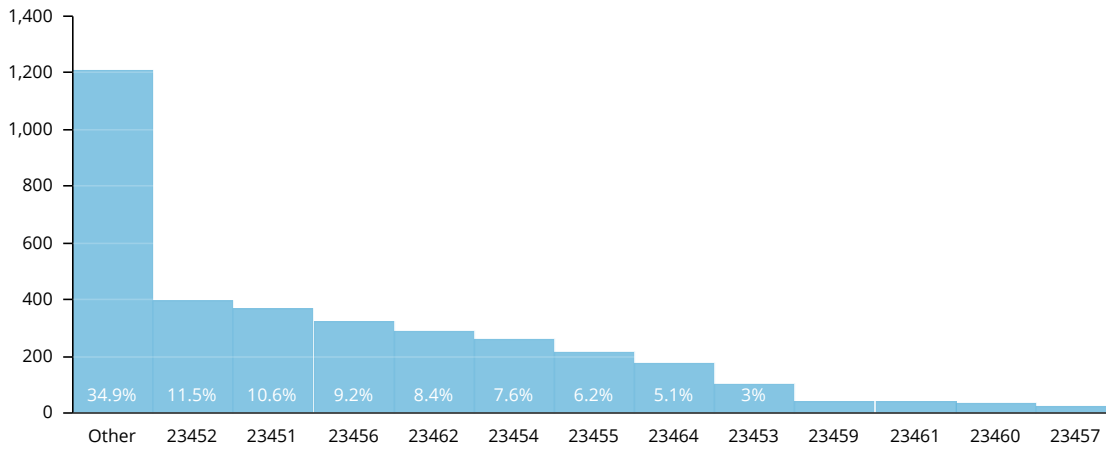

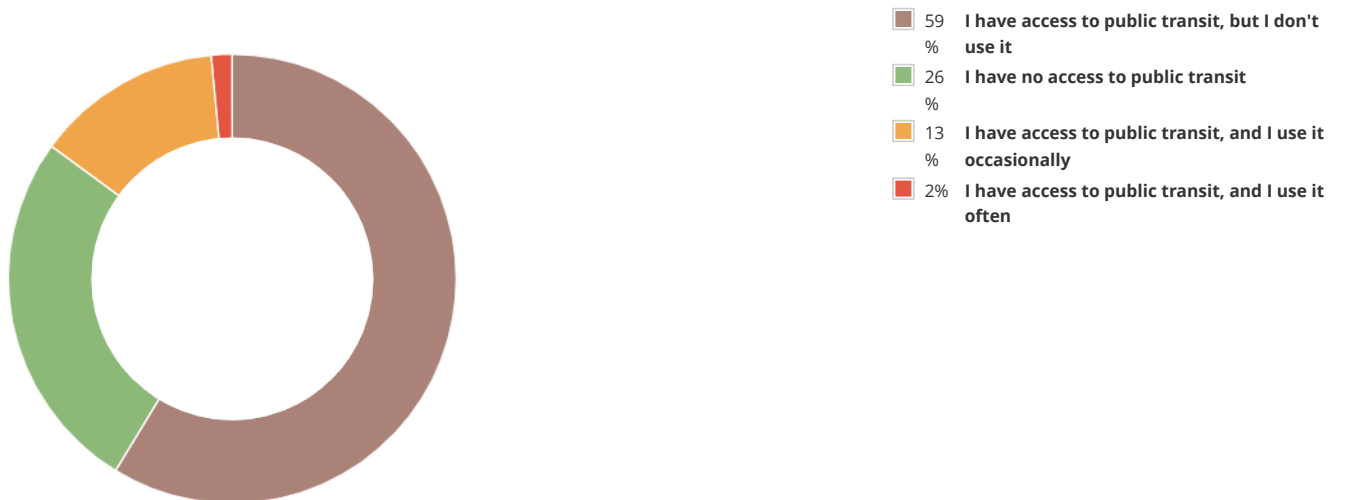
13. What is the zip code of your primary *home residence*?

15. Please select the response below that best describes your knowledge and use of public transit.



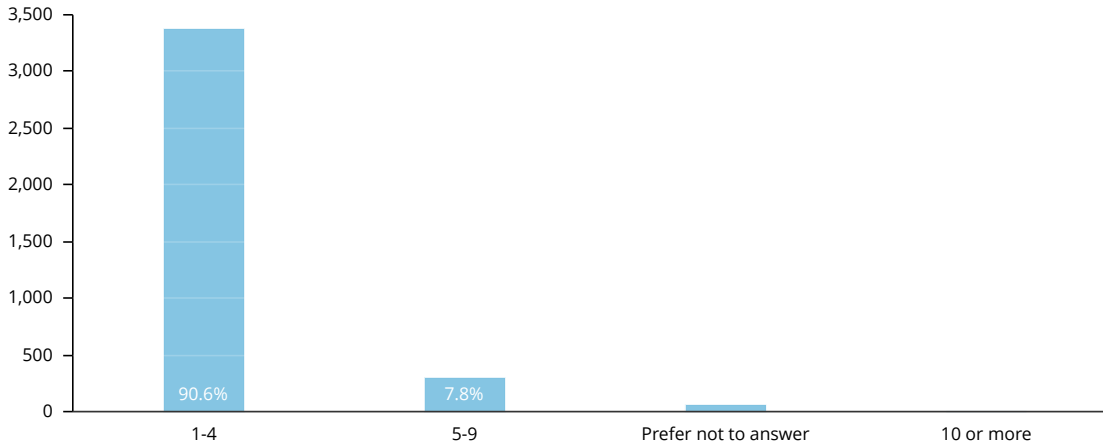

16. What are *your* barriers in using public transit services or using them more frequently? (Check all that apply)

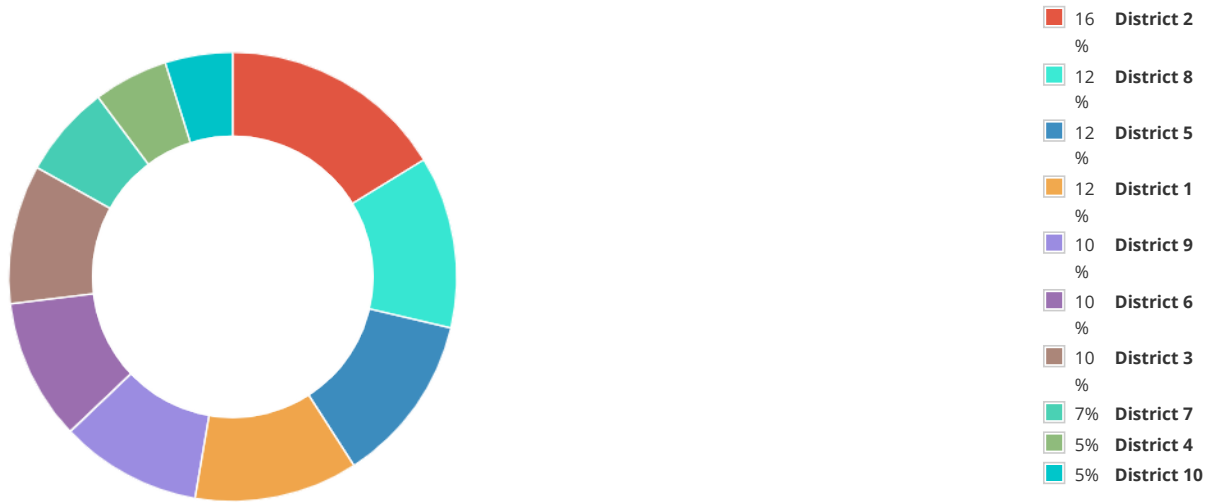

17. How many people live in your household, full-time, including yourself?

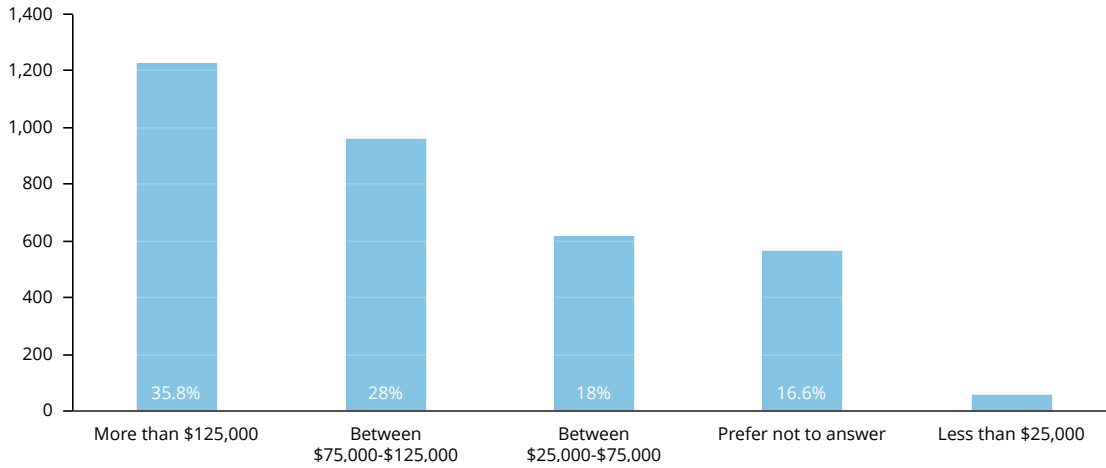


* 18. In what local election district do you reside?

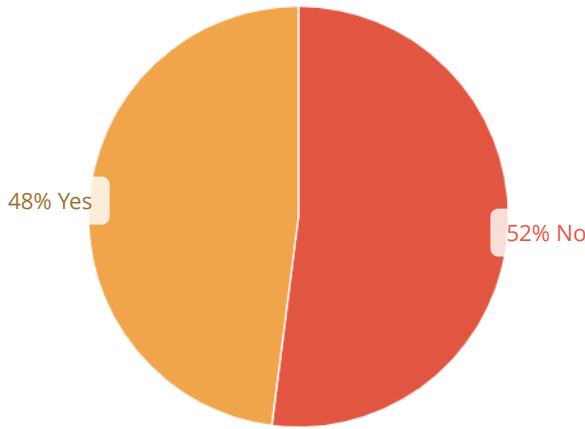

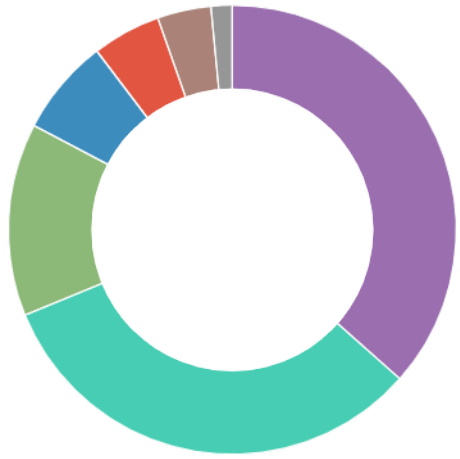
